CELLISSIMO — 08 May 17:00 | R200 | Dutch Reformed Church, Greyton

Six celli of the Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra will play a beautiful programme ranging from traditional classics to popular tunes from the silver screen with Peter Martens, Eddie McLean, Matthias Remley-Ender, Ashlin Grobbelaar, Rosemund Roth and Dane Coetzee.

CLASSIC ZANNE — 08 May 19:00 | R200 | Greyton Moravian Church

Favourite soprano, Zanne Stapelberg, with pianist Albie van Schalkwyk and an ensemble of Suretha du Toit on clarinet, with a violin and cello, present classical favourites, musical theatre gems, operatic highlights such as Song to the Moon from Dvorák's Rusalka, Quando m'en vo from Puccini's La Bohème, and If I Loved You from Carousel.
